## **DVxT Theatre Company**

DVxT has been a dynamic part of Toronto's theatre community for over ten years. In the equation that inspires our artistic practice, time is the most important variable. By affording our creative team extended periods of time to develop and rehearse each work, we allow the company to travel artistically at the right speed, resulting in award-winning, stylish and entertaining theatre.

DVxT has garnered 19 Dora Award Nominations and 12 Dora Awards for their memorable work. We have developed 5 new Canadian scripts and presented classics from the restoration, to Ibsen to Beckett. We portray stories that are relevant to a modern audience, exploring themes of personal and political identity.

### **Current Project**

#### In Development for 2012-2013: Under the Influence (working title) by John Murrell

DVxT recently commissioned the acclaimed Canadian playwright John Murrell (*Waiting for the Parade, Democracy*) to write a new play for actors Brian Dennehy, Bruce Godfree and Daniela Vlaskalic.

We workshopped the first draft last summer at the Stratford Shakespeare Festival and this spring we travelled to the Goodman Theatre in Chicago to read the final draft. We are in discussion with the Goodman and several Canadian producers to plan a Canadian-American premiere of the play in 2012-13.

Envisioning the project, Brian led by talking about how he was always trying to get to the heart of the Canadian-American relationship with his Canadian colleagues, but to no avail. We mused that possibly Canadians were too self-effacing and polite to actually get to the truth of it with our American friends, but that indeed, it was a discussion worth having; and worth having onstage.

We talked about two main characters – a cynical, fading American writer and a younger, shrewd Canadian professor – and the kind of circumstances that would bring them together. John percolated and Dennehy's "Niall" and Vlaskalic's "Giovanna" were born: two characters who stand on either sides of national, political, professional and generational borders. A foil to "Niall", a young British teaching assistant, "Geoff" rounds out the cast.

DVxT looks forward to bringing you more information about *Under the Influence* as we prepare to read the final draft at the Goodman Theatre this spring.

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## **Arts Literacy Education**

DVxT Theatre Company continues to inspire and enrich our community's youth through our Arts Literacy Education programme. Since our inception, we have fostered relationships with educators and students across the GTA.

For three previous productions (*The Doll House, St. Christopher* and *The Turn of the Screw*) we created a study guide to help teachers and students prepare for the performance. Our student programme is always a huge success; teachers used our guides in their classrooms, we sell-out our student matinées and enjoy illuminating dialogues between students, teachers and artists during our talkback sessions following each performance.

DVxT believes arts programs for students are essential tools for learning. In today's age of multimedia and technology students often face challenges in learning how to communicate clearly and articulate their thoughts.

To succeed in today's economy of ideas, students must attain competency by using words, images, sounds and motion to communicate.
